Dear Parent,

Here is some information on New Hope House that you requested. Our desire is to open the door of freedom in Christ to girls on the verge of making decisions that will have life long consequences.

New Hope is located in Tooele, Utah, 25 minutes southwest of the Salt Lake City airport. It is a community of 21,000 people located in a valley surrounded by mountains and the Great Salt Lake. The house is a former convent that has been re-modeled into a lovely home and school/chapel.

The girls that come to New Hope are seeking to overcome life-controlling problems and have a desire to find a future and purpose for their lives. Our goals are to instill an understanding of the value of their life, their responsibility for their choices and reintegration into their families. While many of the girls are from Utah and Colorado, other states are represented as well.

We accept referrals from private homes, churches, and other programs. Priority of services will be to those students who **voluntarily** desire help. Intake will be limited to those students that can mentally and physically function within the controlled structure of the program. Students who are on psychotropic drugs or are in need of constant mental therapy may be outside the scope of our program.

In order for an applicant to be accepted, we must have received and reviewed the written full application. Copies of student's immunization card, birth certificate, social security card, school academic records and a record of a physical examination dated not more than one month prior to admittance are required to be on file at New Hope House.

The New Hope residents will be able to continue academic progress through New Hope alternative school. This is a diagnostic school curriculum that meets the girls at their level based on their testing.

Please note that this is a voluntary program. **This is a religious training facility, NOT a treatment program.** This is not a lock up facility and the girls must be willing to attend. There are other programs that are stronger and that may suit some girl's needs better. We are happy to do referrals if needed.

We will be praying for you and your daughter. Please do not hesitate to call if you have questions or concerns.
